



Bushy Hill Families,

Please note that any medications sent to camp **MUST** be in the original packaging and labeled with your child's name, name of medication, direction for the medication's administration and the date it was prescribed. Each medication sent to camp must have its own form filled out and signed by your child's physician and a legal guardian.

Please note that while we do not have a licensed nurse on staff, we do have a Medical Director with First Aid, CPR, AED for the Professional Rescuer and Lifeguarding certifications who oversees all incidents requiring medical attention. In addition, every counselor has their Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR and AED certifications. Our Counselor Assistants have a minimum of First Aid/CPR/AED for Professional Rescuer certifications. On site there are two licensed nurses at the Pequot-Sherwood Residential Camp's Health Center. In an emergency, we do have access to the nurses. Dr. Geoff at Wildwood Pediatrics is our camp's physician and the Middlesex Hospital Shoreline Medical Center is a few miles down the road. All Bushy Hill staff members 18 years and older are also trained to administer medications as prescribed by your child's physician.

Your child's safety and well-being is our number one priority.
